August 16, 2022 - Rachel Debigare, Executive Director for The Education Foundation of Alachua County has announced her departure from The Education Foundation effective September 30, 2022. Debigare, who became the Program Director for The Education Foundation in January 2012 has served as Executive Director since June 2017.

“Rachel was a tremendous leader for our organization, and we are thankful for everything that she accomplished in the past decade,” said Tim Roark, Board President for The Education Foundation of Alachua County. “The Pandemic produced countless challenges over the last few years, however The Education Foundation continued to excel thanks to Rachel’s leadership and commitment to excellence. After finishing her tenure at The Education Foundation, Debigare will transition to working as a financial advisor, joining her father at his financial planning practice.

Although the announcement is just now being made public, Debigare shared news of her departure with The Education Foundation Board of Directors at the end of May. Since that time the search committee worked quickly, and The Education Foundation is delighted to announce Jayne Moraski as the new Executive Director. Moraski is familiar with the Gainesville nonprofit community, having most recently served as Executive Director for Family Promise of Gainesville.

“We are excited for Jayne to lead The Foundation to new heights,” said Roark. “Jayne understands our mission and how this organization impacts our community. She is a proven leader with a track record of impressive results, having grown Family Promise from serving 50 people to 250 people annually. Jayne is the right person to guide The Education Foundation forward, and we are eager to see what she will accomplish!”

Moraski will begin at The Education Foundation September 6, 2022.
